The courses are designed to assist job seekers and or those who would like to try out new skills for a new career. The courses include nationally recognised units of competency, consist of small class sizes and are delivered in CfAT's Alice Springs premises.

Our courses are delivered in specifically designed and equipped workshops by industry experienced and vocationally qualified training staff.

Fully enclosed shoes/boots and appropriate clothing will be required. Other personal Protection Equipment (PPE) such as safety goggles, gloves, ear plugs etc., will be provided.

CfAT will ensure that current NT Government social distancing and good hygiene practices will be strictly followed.
